Case Study

The paving to Main Street and its surrounding areas in the Bellshill Town Centre: Phase 4; redevelopment for North Lanarkshire Council, included Porphyry Granite Setts, Caithness Stone and Grey Granite edging blocks. These have all been laid by RJ McLeod (Contractors) Ltd. of Glasgow, using the unique **vdw 850** Paving Jointing Mortar from **NCC Streetscape**.

The Council and their Consultants researched the best jointing solutions for the turning areas and specified the option of using **GftK's vdw 850** Paving Jointing Mortar. This was because it is extremely durable, resistant to freeze thaw actions with de-icing salts and it can easily accommodate all the different loadings required, including those in this turning area outside of St. Andrews Church.

RJ McLeod also then made a complete evaluation of the different options, including the costs of the labour and plant, plus the potential for any delays due to the weather, which would have huge time and cost implications. As a result **GftK's vdw 850** Jointing Mortar was also by far the most cost effective solution. It is quickly and easily applied and cures, even in wet weather conditions and at low temperatures. This meant that the paving jointing works could continue to schedule, even during the Scottish winter weather.
