



Pophyry Stone Driveway Grappenhall, Cheshire

Case Study

This driveway was designed in a traditional fan pattern with natural porphyry stone setts in its familiar mixed red colour. The paving was all pointed using **GftK's vdw 850**; the unique epoxy resin bound sand based, paving joint mortar from **NCC Streetscape**.

The **vdw 850** jointing mortar was selected because it is not only good looking, but also extremely durable and easily able to accommodate the frequent vehicle traffic over the driveway, together with that of visiting delivery vehicles. Additionally it will prevent both weed growth and burrowing insect attack, plus the jointing work had to be completed quickly and on schedule, in order to enable access to the property, without delays due to the cold, wet and damp weather that was forecast.

GftK's vdw 850 is slurry applied on to pre-dampened surfaces and rinsed with additional water; therefore it is not necessary to wait for the paved areas to dry out before pointing after wet and rainy weather. It is easily applied using a squeegee and it self-compacts into the joints so no additional hand pointing or compacting is necessary, and then the surface is simply rinsed and brushed off.
