Case Study

This front patio terrace and pathways in St. Mary's Road, Bolton is laid in a random pattern using Grey Indian Limestone in random sized slabs to make the most of the whole of the relatively small area for the owners to use and access in all weathers.

Local specialists, Patio Craft Building & Cleaning, selected **vdw 840plus** as the most suitable paving jointing mortar because it is moisture tolerant during application, so there is no waiting for completely dry weather conditions; in fact the area is also thoroughly pre-wetted before beginning the application.

Vdw 840plus is an advanced, one-component, polymeric sand based jointing mortar for use in domestic, non-trafficked areas. It is quickly and easily slurry applied by squeegee using more water and it effectively self-compacts into the joints. After a few minutes drying any excess is brushed off and the surface is given a final rinse – Job done!
