Case Study

Natural Porphyry Granite Setts plus Grey Granite Edging Blocks and Setts have been used for the entrance areas to local businesses and other areas in the Bellshill Town Centre: Phase 4; redevelopment for North Lanarkshire Council. RJ McLeod (Contractors) Ltd of Glasgow undertook the paving works successfully and on time by using **GftK's vdw 850** Paving Jointing Mortar.

This is a unique, epoxy resin bound sand system that is rapidly slurry applied 'standing-up' to the pre-dampened paving where it actually 'self-compacts' into the joints, without the need to work on your hands and knees to point or otherwise finish them. The material is also non-staining, it dramatically reduces waste and run-off, and it is suitable for the jointing of many different types of paving, including both pedestrian and vehicular traffic areas. This is because of the ideal correlation between its compressive and tensile strengths, plus a high modulus of elasticity.

Additionally the advanced **vdw 850** Paving Jointing Mortar from **NCC Streetscape** allows work to continue in wet and rainy weather, where it still hardens quickly, even at low temperatures, so projects can be completed without delays – even in the renowned Scottish weather.
